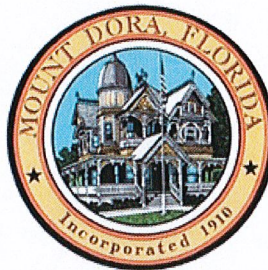

DISCUSSION ITEMS

1. Parking

Adam Sumner, Deputy Planning and Zoning Director/CRA Manager, provided the Council with an overview of the agenda item and went over a presentation of the parking within the City which is attached as Exhibit "A".

Mr. Sumner spoke about the parking history, solutions, and needed inventory.

Discussion ensued on paid parking and parking garages,

Chief Bret Meade inquired about the alleyways within downtown and mentioned bringing back an ordinance change in regards to restricting parking in the alleyways within the downtown area.

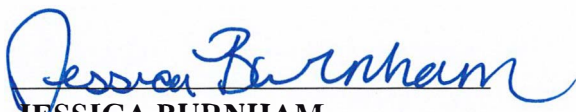
