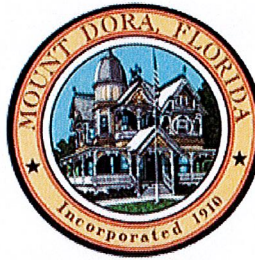

DISCUSSION ITEMS

1. Northeast Community Resource Center

Adam Sumner, CRA Administer, provided the Council with the history of the discussion item.

Discussion took place about settling the location of the Resource Center, the history of the item, staffing the center, and cost associated with the project.

2. Community Tree Canopy

Joe Grusauskas, Public Works & Utilities Director, spoke on the item and stated the city operates and follows the code.

Robert Harper, Public Works Manager, discussed the definition of a dangerous tree, the cause of a diseased tree, and the tree program.

Discussion ensued on assessing trees, trimming/ pruning trees, and what trees are considered for replacement trees.

Discussion then continued on the possibility of having a third party arborist, the possibility of having a tree committee/board, tree inventory, and the neighborhood tree program.

3. Recycling

Mr. Grusauskas spoke about the item and briefly gave the council the history of the item,

Discussion ensued on the contract with waste management, possibly re-educating the public on the current program, and increasing the drop off sites within the city.
