Introduction:

This is a request for Council to conclude the discussion regarding the City Manager.

Discussion:

At the May 16, 2023, City Council meeting, Mayor Stile initiated discussion regarding the City Manager. A motion was made for Councilmember Cataldo to contact the Florida League of Cities for an immediate meeting with the City Attorney, the City Manager, Councilmember Cataldo and a Florida League of Cities designee for a series of meetings to give the City Manager an opportunity for input. It was found a designee was not available from the Florida League of Cities for this purpose. The motion further directed Councilmember Dawson to work with the City's Human Resources department to create a survey for those who report directly to the City Manager, which may also involve interviews.

The Florida League of Cities does not offer resources meeting this purpose, but supplied a list of contacts who may be able to assist in this process. Human Resources spoke with a number of direct reports, using a survey to gather feedback from direct reports.

At this time, results from these processes will be reported.

This item was originally placed on the June 20, 2023 City Council Regular Session agenda. However, on June 14, 2023, Mayor Crissy Stile called for an Emergency Special Meeting to be held on Thursday, June 15th, 7 p.m., at which this item would be addressed.
