1. Request Adoption of **Resolution No. 2024-40**, State of Emergency Related to Tropical Storm Milton

The City Clerk read Resolution No. 2024-40, State of Emergency Related to Tropical Storm Milton, by title only.

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-40

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MOUNT DORA, FLORIDA, PERTAINING TO THE LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY STEMMING FROM TROPICAL STORM MILTON; PROVIDING THE MAYOR AND THE CITY MANAGER WITH EMERGENCY POWERS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THOSE PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 252, FLORIDA STATUTES, THE CITY CHARTER, AND CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS AND INTENT; PROVIDING FOR THE DECLARATION OF A LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY; PROVIDING FOR THE INAPPLICABILITY OF EMERGENCY EVENT RESPONSE PAY; PROVIDING FOR THE DURATION OF THE LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY; PROVIDING FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIONS; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR SCRIVENER'S ERRORS, PROVIDING FOR

CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN
EFFECTIVE DATE.

Mr. Sandersfeld described the purpose of the resolution, which is a necessary measure the City must take to allow unforeseen spending in response to the storm. He told Council that staff recommends that Council adopt the resolution.

Council and staff discussed the imposition of a curfew.

Mayor Stile opened public comment. No one spoke. Mayor Stile closed public comment.

Purchasing Manager Whitney Donovan spoke to Council about signing the notice to proceed with the City's debris monitoring and collection services agreement.

MOTION BY COUNCILMEMBER ROLFSON TO ADOPT RESOLUTION NO. 2024-40, STATE OF EMERGENCY RELATED TO HURRICANE MILTON; COUNCILMEMBER WALKER SECONDED THE MOTION. MOTION PASSED WITH A 4-0 ROLL CALL VOTE.

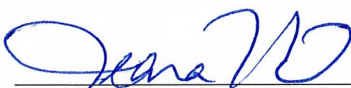
No other business was discussed.

ADJOURNMENT

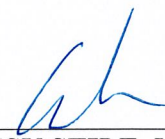
Council thanked those who would be working through and after the storm.
