**SUBJECT:** Interlocal Agreement with Lake County Regarding Tax Increment Revenues for the Northeast Community Redevelopment Area Expansion

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**Introduction:**

This is a request for the Board to consider an Interlocal Agreement with Lake County regarding tax increment revenues for the Northeast Community Redevelopment Area (CRA) Expansion.

**Discussion:**

On February 17, 2026, a shade meeting with the City Council, City Attorney, City Manager, and a court reporter was held pursuant to Section 286.011(8), Florida Statutes, to discuss pending litigation against the City and the Northeast Community Redevelopment Agency. The shade meeting resulted from Lake County, Florida v. City of Mount Dora, et al., Case No. 2025-CA-00766, currently pending in the Fifth Judicial Circuit Court for Lake County, Florida. Discussions were confined to settlement negotiations and strategy related to litigation expenditures.

After the shade meeting concluded and the public meeting was reopened, the City Council voted to direct the City Attorney to prepare a draft counteroffer with changes to Section 2.01(iii) of the Lake County's proposed Option 1 Interlocal Agreement, providing the Northeast CRA receive or retain 55% of the tax increment financing (TIF) payable from Lake County and that Lake County retain 45% of the portion of such increment from its General Fund under Section 163.387(1), Florida Statutes. The City Attorney has prepared a proposed revision to Section 2.01(iii), consistent with the City Council's direction, for the Northeast CRA Board and City Council to consider as a formal counteroffer. The proposed changes provide clarification as to where and what the Lake County's retained General Fund revenues should be spent, within and adjacent to the Northeast CRA Boundary, for County road, intersection, sidewalk, and stormwater management repairs and improvements. The proposed language specifies that said funds should first be used for Limit Avenue from Donnelly Street to U.S. 441 and Pine Avenue from N. Wardell St. to U.S. 441.

**Budget Impact:**

The Northeast CRA Expansion areas include all land value, Phase One Commercial, all residential, and Phase Two Commercial properties. These estimates are calculated for the remaining life of the CRA (sunset year 2049), assuming a 3% annual increase in property values using current millage rates.

**Ambulance MSTU**

Lake County would retain one hundred percent (100%) of the increment accruable to and payable from Lake County's Ambulance MSTU that is derived from the Redevelopment Area, including the Expansion Area. The resulting annual revenue decrease to the Northeast CRA funds is \$67,440 based on 2025 tax roll data. Based on a 3% growth rate and the MSTU millage rate staying the same, the total revenue through 2049 would be \$2,460,190. This roughly the annual cost of one EMT for the life of the agency. This decrease will be offset by the new TIF paid from the expansion area, given the residential population of the Northeast CRA, the Expansion area and the commercial development in the expansion area, this is an appropriate use of this retained MSTU revenue for the Lake County Ambulance service.

The chart above is the projected TIF Revenues paid to the Northeast CRA over the life of the agency by the taxing authorities based on different percentages that have been discussed. The **positive** numbers are the totals of the annual TIF payments to the Northeast CRA from the taxing authorities. The **negative** numbers are the general fund revenues retained by the taxing authorities. TIF restrictions do **not apply to the retained general fund revenues for the taxing authorities**. Please keep in mind the perspective that these projections are presented from. These are TIF Revenue projections prepared by the CRA staff for the purpose of

budgeting for future projects and expenses. Any reduction from the 95% state allotment or the 75% offer that the Northeast CRA made is a reduction in future revenue, hence the depiction as a negative number in the chart above. The negative numbers are positive revenue savings for the taxing authorities.

**Strategic Impact:**

CRA revenue policy decisions are a core fiscal governance function and align with using restricted funds to the fullest ability and managing long-term financial sustainability.

**INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN  
LAKE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AND  
CITY OF MOUNT DORA, FLORIDA  
REGARDING TAX INCREMENT REVENUES**

**THIS INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT** (the “Agreement”) is made by and between **LAKE COUNTY**, a political subdivision existing under the Constitution and State Laws of Florida (“County”), the **CITY OF MOUNT DORA**, a municipal corporation existing under the State of Laws of Florida (“Mount Dora”), and the **NORTHEAST COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY**, a dependent special district (“Agency”); collectively (the “Parties”).

**WHEREAS**, Lake County is a non-chartered political subdivision of the State of Florida; and

**WHEREAS**, Mount Dora is a municipal corporation existing under the laws of State of Florida; and

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 163, Part III, Florida Statutes, known as the “Community Redevelopment Act of 1969” (the “Redevelopment Act”) governs the creation and operation of community redevelopment agencies; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Redevelopment Act, the City of Mount Dora created the Northeast Community Redevelopment Agency within its boundaries, which is a duly created and existing community redevelopment agency authorized to receive “increment revenues” (“Increment”) as defined in Section 163.340(22), Florida Statutes, and calculated pursuant to Section 163.387(1), Florida Statutes; and

**WHEREAS**, the Agency oversees the Trust Fund for the Northeast Redevelopment Area (the “Redevelopment Area”); and

**WHEREAS**, on March 18, 2025, Mount Dora adopted Ordinance No. 2024-20, modifying the boundaries of the Redevelopment Area and adopting the Northeast Community Agency Redevelopment Plan 2024; and

**WHEREAS**, the area of the Agency’s boundary expansion adopted via Ordinance No. 2024-20 (as may have been subsequently amended to correct any scrivener’s errors) is described and graphically depicted in **Exhibit A**, attached hereto (the “Expansion Area”); and

**WHEREAS**, Section 163.01, Florida Statutes, known as the “Florida Interlocal Cooperation Act of 1969,” (the “Cooperation Act”) permits local governmental units to make the most efficient use of their powers by enabling them to cooperate with other localities on a basis of mutual advantage, and thereby to provide services and facilities in a manner and pursuant to forms of governmental organization that will accord best with geographic, economic, population, and other factors influencing the needs and development of local communities; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parties find this Interlocal Agreement to be necessary, proper, and convenient to the exercise of their powers, duties, and purposes authorized by law; and

**WHEREAS**, this Interlocal Agreement is entered into pursuant to the powers and authority granted to the Parties under the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, including, but not limited to the authority of Section 163.01, Florida Statutes; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 163.387(3)(b), Florida Statutes, provides that alternate provisions contained in an interlocal agreement between a taxing authority and the governing body that created the community redevelopment agency may supersede the provisions of this section with respect to that taxing authority; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parties wish to enter into this Agreement pursuant to provisions of Section 163.387(3)(b); and

**WHEREAS**, the Parties are in agreement that a portion of the current amount of Increment as calculated pursuant to Section 163.387(1) paid by the Parties to the Trust Fund of the Redevelopment Area is not currently necessary for redevelopment purposes; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parties are in agreement that reduction of such Increment paid by Lake County and Mount Dora would allow both entities to use the funds comprising such reduction for general governmental purposes (as well ambulance services in the case of Lake County); and

**WHEREAS**, the Parties wish to exercise jointly their common powers and authority concerning the amount of appropriation of Increment to the Trust Fund for the Redevelopment Area which will result in Lake County's and Mount Dora's retention of a portion of each Party's Increment payment calculated pursuant to Section 163.387(1), Florida Statutes, as specified herein.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, it is hereby agreed by the Parties as follows:

## **ARTICLE I INTRODUCTION**

**Section 1.01**     **Authority.** This Interlocal Agreement is entered into pursuant to the authority set forth in the Cooperation Act, the Redevelopment Act, and other applicable laws.

**Section 1.02**     **Recitals and Exhibits.** The recitals so stated are true and correct and by this reference are incorporated herein.

**Section 1.03**     **Authority to Contract.** The execution of this Interlocal Agreement has been duly authorized by the appropriate official bodies of the Parties, each Party has complied with all applicable requirements of law, and each Party has full power and authority to comply with the terms and provisions of this instrument.

## ARTICLE II INCREMENT REVENUES

**Section 2.01 Northeast Community Redevelopment Area.** The Parties agree that Increment for the Redevelopment Area shall continue to be calculated pursuant to Section 163.387(1) of the Act.

- (i) Notwithstanding same, commencing on January 1, 2026, and on each January 1 thereafter for the duration of the time period that Increment for the Redevelopment Area accruable to Lake County continues to become due, Lake County shall, as consideration for entering into this Agreement:
  - (a) Retain **Forty Five Percent (45%)** of the portion of such Increment accruable to and payable from Lake County's General Fund which is derived from the Expansion Area.
  - (b) Retain **One Hundred Percent (100%)** of the portion of such Increment accruable to and payable from Lake County's Ambulance MSTU which is derived from the Redevelopment Area including the Expansion Area.
- (ii) Notwithstanding same, commencing on January 1, 2026, and on each January 1 thereafter for the duration of the time period that Increment for the Redevelopment Area accruable to Agency continues to become due, Agency shall, as consideration for entering into this Agreement ~~retain~~ receive **Fifty Five Percent (55%)** of the portion of such Increment accruable to and payable from Lake County's General Fund which is derived from the Expansion Area.
- (iii) Lake County hereby agrees, to the greatest extent possible ~~and where warranted~~, to use its share of the retained incremental General Fund revenues for County road, intersection, improvements, sidewalks, and stormwater management repairs and improvements associated with County owned and maintained roads ~~within or near or~~ adjacent to the Redevelopment Area including, ~~but not limited to, first to~~ Limit Avenue from Donnelly Street to U.S. 441 and Pine Avenue from N. Wardell St. to U.S. 441, but also to other such County transportation or stormwater management facilities within or adjacent to the Redevelopment Agency Boundary Area, State Road 44 (f/k/a County Road 44B) and U.S. 441.

## ARTICLE III MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

**Section 3.01 Limitations on Governmental Liability.** Nothing in this Interlocal Agreement shall be deemed a waiver of immunity limits of liability of any of the Parties beyond any statutory limited waiver of immunity or limits of liability contained in Section 768.28, Florida Statutes, as amended, or other statutes. Nothing in this Interlocal Agreement shall inure to the benefit of any third-party for the purpose of allowing any claim, which would otherwise be barred under the Doctrine of Sovereign Immunity or by operation of law.

**Section 3.02 Negotiation at Arm's Length.** This Interlocal Agreement has been negotiated fully between the Parties as an arm's length transaction and with the assistance of legal counsel. All Parties participated fully in the preparation of this Interlocal Agreement. In the case of a dispute concerning the interpretation of any provision of this Interlocal Agreement, the Parties are deemed to have drafted, chosen, and selected the language, and the language in question will not be interpreted or construed against any of the Parties.

**Section 3.03 Notices.** Any notices required or allowed to be delivered shall be in writing and be deemed to be delivered when: (i) hand delivered to the official hereinafter designated, or (ii) upon receipt of such notice when deposited in the United States mail, postage prepaid, certified mail, return receipt requested, addressed to a Party at the address set forth opposite the Party's name below, or at such other address as the Party shall have specified by written notice to the other Parties delivered in accordance herewith.

**Section 3.04 Assignment or Transfer.** No Party may assign or transfer its rights or obligations under this Interlocal Agreement to another unit of local government, political subdivision, or agency of the State of Florida without the prior written consent of the other Parties. No Party may transfer its rights or obligations under this Interlocal Agreement to a private party or entity.

**Section 3.05 Binding Effect.** This Agreement shall be binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of the Lake County, Mount Dora, the Agency, and their respective successors.

**Section 3.06 Filing.** The Mount Dora City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed, after approval of this Interlocal Agreement by the respective governing bodies of the Parties and the execution thereof by the duly qualified and authorized officers of each of the Parties hereto, to cause this Interlocal Agreement to be filed with the Clerk of the Circuit Court in Lake County, Florida, in accordance with the requirements of Section 163.01(11) of the Cooperation Act.

**Section 3.07 Applicable Law and Venue.** This Interlocal Agreement and the provisions contained herein shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida. Venue shall lie in Lake County, Florida for any action, in equity or law, with respect to the enforcement or interpretation of this Interlocal Agreement.

**Section 3.08 Severability.** If any part of this Interlocal Agreement is held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable, such invalid, illegal or unenforceable part shall be deemed severable and the remaining parts of this Interlocal Agreement shall continue in full force and effect provided that the rights and obligations of the Parties are not materially prejudiced and the intentions of the Parties can continue to be effected.

**Section 3.09 Joint Effort.** The preparation of this Interlocal Agreement has been a joint effort of the Parties hereto and the resulting document shall not, solely as a matter of judicial construction, be construed more severely against one of the Parties than the other.

**Section 3.10 No Third-Party Beneficiaries.** This Agreement is an administrative agreement generated solely for the benefit of the Parties hereto and no right or cause of action shall accrue by reason of or for the benefit of any third-party. Nothing in this Agreement, expressed or implied, is intended nor shall it be construed to confer upon or give any person or entity any right, remedy, or claim under or by reason of this Agreement or any provisions or conditions hereof, other than the Parties hereto and their respective representatives, heirs, successors, and assigns.

**Section 3.11 Mutual Cooperation.** The Parties agree to cooperate and deliver any further documents or perform any additional acts to accomplish the agreements set forth herein.

**Section 3.12 Construction.** This Interlocal Agreement is the result of the negotiations among and between the Parties and such that all Parties have contributed materially and substantially to its preparation and shall not be construed more strictly against one party than the other.

**Section 3.13 Intent and Interpretation.** This Agreement shall not be construed as modifying or altering the governmental powers of the Parties as they now exist or may be modified in the future, except as are lawfully and expressly provided by the terms of this Agreement.

**Section 3.14 Entire Agreement.** This instrument and its exhibits constitute the entire agreement between the Parties and supersede all previous discussions, understandings and agreements between the Parties relating to the subject matter of this Agreement. Amendments to and waivers of the provisions herein shall be made by the Parties in writing by formal amendment.

**Section 3.15 Effective Date.** This Interlocal Agreement shall become effective upon the filing of same pursuant to Section 3.06 above.

**Section 3.04 Assignment or Transfer.** No Party may assign or transfer its rights or obligations under this Interlocal Agreement to another unit of local government, political subdivision, or agency of the State of Florida without the prior written consent of the other Parties. No Party may transfer its rights or obligations under this Interlocal Agreement to a private party or entity.

**Section 3.05 Binding Effect.** This Agreement shall be binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of the Lake County, Mount Dora, the Agency, and their respective successors.

**Section 3.06 Filing.** The Mount Dora City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed, after approval of this Interlocal Agreement by the respective governing bodies of the Parties and the execution thereof by the duly qualified and authorized officers of each of the Parties hereto, to cause this Interlocal Agreement to be filed with the Clerk of the Circuit Court in Lake County, Florida, in accordance with the requirements of Section 163.01(11) of the Cooperation Act.

**Section 3.07 Applicable Law and Venue.** This Interlocal Agreement and the provisions contained herein shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida. Venue shall lie in Lake County, Florida for any action, in equity or law, with respect to the enforcement or interpretation of this Interlocal Agreement.

**Section 3.08 Severability.** If any part of this Interlocal Agreement is held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable, such invalid, illegal or unenforceable part shall be deemed severable and the remaining parts of this Interlocal Agreement shall continue in full force and effect provided that the rights and obligations of the Parties are not materially prejudiced and the intentions of the Parties can continue to be effected.

**Section 3.09 Joint Effort.** The preparation of this Interlocal Agreement has been a joint effort of the Parties hereto and the resulting document shall not, solely as a matter of judicial construction, be construed more severely against one of the Parties than the other.

**Section 3.10 No Third-Party Beneficiaries.** This Agreement is an administrative agreement generated solely for the benefit of the Parties hereto and no right or cause of action shall accrue by reason of or for the benefit of any third-party. Nothing in this Agreement, expressed or implied, is intended nor shall it be construed to confer upon or give any person or entity any right, remedy, or claim under or by reason of this Agreement or any provisions or conditions hereof, other than the Parties hereto and their respective representatives, heirs, successors, and assigns.

**Section 3.11 Mutual Cooperation.** The Parties agree to cooperate and deliver any further documents or perform any additional acts to accomplish the agreements set forth herein.

**Section 3.12 Construction.** This Interlocal Agreement is the result of the negotiations among and between the Parties and such that all Parties have contributed materially and substantially to its preparation and shall not be construed more strictly against one party than the other.

**Section 3.13 Intent and Interpretation.** This Agreement shall not be construed as modifying or altering the governmental powers of the Parties as they now exist or may be modified in the future, except as are lawfully and expressly provided by the terms of this Agreement.

**Section 3.14 Entire Agreement.** This instrument and its exhibits constitute the entire agreement between the Parties and supersede all previous discussions, understandings and agreements between the Parties relating to the subject matter of this Agreement. Amendments to and waivers of the provisions herein shall be made by the Parties in writing by formal amendment.

**Section 3.15 Effective Date.** This Interlocal Agreement shall become effective upon the filing of same pursuant to Section 3.06 above.
